- Chair meetings and assign tasks.
- Represent the festival via publicity with media outlets.
- Oversee and monitor BQFF volunteers, and their roles, and assign tasks where required.
- Prepare annual reports.
- Prepare strategic and operational plan.
- Ensure values and mission are upheld and reviewed where necessary.
- Provide the vision and drive the festival committee to achieve common goals.
- Liaise with key stakeholders, sponsors and VIP's.
- Book venues for events.
